
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SWSGA Spring Jam, March 25, 2023



Neuropathy and spinal issues sidelined my Williams playing. Nearly brand new and in the box since early 2017 due to medical issues that are not resolving. Cost \$4K new. The Williams Axe and Case weigh-in at just under 50 lbs, which was desirable for packing.

This is a Keyless version of the guitar pictured on the Williams Website. The copedent is Extended E9 with the "Day" setup (A & C + E & F swap). String 6 has split tuning.
